The board also desires that the Superintendent, or his designee, perform the duties of clerk and treasurer."

	The board annually authorizes the agents of the board to lease, purchase and contract for goods and services in order to streamline the business function of the district. The following resolution will accomplish this: "RESOLVED, that the school board desires to have the Superintendent of Schools properly authorized to enter into leases on behalf of the board, and to purchase and contract for goods and services within general budget categories."

	MN Statute provides that claims against the district may be paid prior to the next school board meeting providing that the board: a. has delegated authority to the clerk or superintendent of schools to make prior payment, and,
	 requires that payment made prior to board approval be acted upon at the next board meeting. This procedure does not affect the right of the district or a taxpayer to challenge the validity of a
	claim.
	The following resolution will accomplish this: "RESOLVED, that the school board wishes to take advantage of payment discounts on purchases and recognize the terms of contracts, purchase orders and vendors. The school board authorizes the superintendent of schools and/or the school board clerk to pay claims against the district prior to a regularly scheduled board meeting if the claim addresses the conditions mentioned in this resolution."
